There will be a brief ceremony followed by open play on the splash pad and a few extra treats. Fingers crossed for a warm, sunny day!



Also new this summer, the Recreation Department is adding theme-based activities to the Market and Concert Series. We love hanging out at the market and concert on a warm summer evening, but we wanted to add a little more excitement to the event. Come out and enjoy the festivities at Family Fun Night, Christmas in July, and the Dog Days of Summer. We always welcome new ideas at Henrietta Parks and Recreation. I was recently approached by two different residents with the idea of building a pump track in Henrietta. A pump track is a looped track for cycling, with a circuit of rollers and berms for the riders to maneuver. Pump tracks are growing in popularity across the nation, thanks in part to their accessibility. They may be used by riders of all ages riding bikes, as well as skateboards, scooters, and wheelchairs. Locally, pump tracks are a relatively new idea. Dirt tracks can be found at Dryer Rd. in Victor and at Makepeace Memorial Pump Track in Naples. Perinton incorporated a pump track as part of the new Perinton Skate Park on 31F. To find out more about skate parks across the nation, visit <https://americanrampcompany.com/velosolutions-asphalt/>. We'd like to hear input from the community regarding this potential project.

If you're thinking of becoming more involved with your community, consider joining the Friends of Henrietta Parks and Recreation. In 2023, this passionate group of volunteers established a non-profit organization dedicated to supporting Parks and Recreation in Henrietta. The talented individuals on this team organize fundraising events, apply for grants to support their projects, and lend a hand to the Recreation Department when needed. Recently, they worked with Wegmans to give roses to all forty-two participants in the Special Olympics New York Winter Gymnastics Games.

The Friends of Henrietta Parks and Recreation are committed to supporting the development and growth of Educator's Grove at Hoskins Park. This masterplan for this project, which honors community educators, has been adopted by the Henrietta Town Board. Members of the Friends Group are working to get information out to the community and secure funding for construction of Educator's Grove. Membership Admission Policies

- Members sign and agree to adhere to the facility code of conduct indicated on the disclaimer.
- Members will receive a keytag to use for scanning into facility.
- Replacement fee for member keytag is \$5.00 per person. (Scan-in required)
- Members receive free access to walking/running track, table tennis, and open gym times. (Scan-in required)
- Scheduled drop-in activities will require a fee and scan-in.
- Drop-in activity daily cost for members and non-members is \$3.00 for residents, \$5.00 for non-residents.
- Scan-in is not required for pre-registered recreation programs, facility rentals, or special events.
- Individuals under the age of 18 must be signed up by their legal guardian.
- Members under age 14 must be supervised by an adult Henrietta Recreation Member age 18+ while using the facility.
- Open gym is open to Members only at this time. Anyone under the age of 18 years old must have parent or guardian sign for their membership or renewal
- Indoor waiting is not allowed. Spectators are not allowed.
- In order to respect the privacy of others, limit photography to your family or group only

REFUND POLICY

Refunds are available as noted below unless otherwise stated in the program description. All refund requests must be submitted to the Henrietta Recreation office in person or by phone. A check will be issued in approximately 2 to 3 weeks. The processing fee for all refunds is \$10

- If a program is cancelled by the Town = FULL REFUND
- MEDICAL REFUND must be accompanied by note from physician. Refund will be prorated from date of injury/accident.
- You may withdraw from a program prior to the start date. Full refund will be granted minus a \$10 processing fee.
- If you withdraw from a program during the FIRST HALF of the program, you will receive a refund of (50%) of the program cost minus a \$10 processing fee.
- REFUNDS WILL NOT be given for missed classes for any (NON-MEDICAL) reasons to anyone who registers for a program but does not attend.
- Once a program has ended REFUNDS WILL NOT be given for any reason.
- Cabin refunds MUST BE AT LEAST TWO WEEKS PRIOR to the date reserved or NO refund will be given. There will be a \$10 processing fee.

HENRIETTA RECREATION DEPARTMENT POLICIES

The Recreation Department reserves the right to cancel or change any program due to low enrollment and may limit the size of any program. Additionally, any program may be cancelled or postponed due to unforeseen conditions which may directly impact the quality or safety of the program. Classes missed because of illness, travel conflicts or personal reasons cannot be made up.

WEATHER RELATED PROGRAM CANCELLATIONS

If the Rush-Henrietta School District is closed due to inclement weather conditions, ALL Henrietta Recreation Programs that are located in a SCHOOL FACILITY are also CANCELLED. If Rush-Henrietta schools close early due to inclement weather conditions, then Recreation Programs scheduled in the schools are also cancelled. For Henrietta Recreation programs that are NOT located in a Rush-Henrietta School District Facility, please call the Henrietta Recreation Department (585) 359-2540 or the weather information line at 585-234-1042 for daily updates regarding program cancellations. When possible, program cancellation information will be communicated to local media. Classes cancelled due to weather or unforeseen circumstances are not eligible for a credit or refund. If possible, make-ups will be scheduled.

Henrietta Parks Information

VETERANS MEMORIAL PARK, 595 Calkins Road

This park has many recreational facilities available to the public including the Henrietta Recreation Center, Senior Center, amphitheater, 3 playgrounds, softball and soccer fields, Roberts and Bushman cabins, picnic pavilions, outdoor restrooms, basketball, pickleball and tennis courts, splash pad and a walking trail that connects to the Lehigh Valley Trail.

MARTIN ROAD PARK, 1344 Martin Road

Features a large playground, Buyck pavilion, outdoor restroom, soccer fields, kick wall, tennis and pickleball courts, and catch and release fishing pond.

LOOKUP PARK, 3850 East Henrietta Road

Amenities include Baldwin Cabin, a 9-hole disc golf short course, golf driving range and dog park. The dog park is self-monitored and is part of the Monroe County Dog Park system. An annual fee will allow you access to dog parks at Lookup Park, Ellison Park, Greece Canal Park, Pittsford Dog Park and Sweden Park. Registration for the dog park is required and can be done at the Henrietta Town Clerk's Office. The golf driving range is operated by the Henrietta Foundation. For hours and additional information regarding the driving range call (585) 334-1300.

BREESE PARK, 108 Westcombe Park

This park features beautiful views of the Genesee River and has an accessible stone dust trail that runs alongside the river. The property is home to many types of wild animals and beautiful plants such as bluebell and trillium flowers, native ferns, mushrooms, black walnut trees, etc. Eagle Scout projects such as a pedestrian walking bridge, kiosk, and wildlife observation blind have been completed here. The newly added Breese Park Play and Fitness trail opened in November 2021.

TINKER NATURE PARK, 1525 Calkins Road

Amenities include the Hansen Nature Center, Tinker Homestead and Farm Museum, Tyler Pavilion, small playground, volleyball court, 2 miles of hiking trails with wetland boardwalks, small amphitheater, gazebo overlooking pond, and the Community Garden Program (registration required). *Please note that dogs are strictly prohibited at Tinker Nature Park

CABIN /PAVILION RESERVATIONS AND FEES

Bushman Cabin, Roberts Cabin, Baldwin Cabin, and pavilions (Tyler, Buyck, Stevens, and Chase) are available to reserve. All cabins are heated and air conditioned and include restrooms, kitchens with oven/stove, refrigerator, sink, and tables with seating for approximately 50-100 people. Cabins and pavilions are available for use from 10:00am to 10:00pm, with the exception of Buyck and Tyler Pavilions, which are available until dusk. Henrietta residents can reserve cabins and pavilions up to 365 days in advance, non-residents up to 335 days in advance.

Reservations must be made in person at the Henrietta Recreation Center or by request online. To make a reservation request online please visit henriettarec.org. A \$100 cleaning deposit in the form of a check is due upon key-pickup for all cabins and Tyler Pavilion. If the facility is left in its original condition, key is returned and rules are followed, your check will be returned to you by mail.
